Partnership for Missional Church

What is Partnership for Missional Church?
Partnership for Missional Church is a three year process of spiritual reflection, transformation and engagement, which is now being launched nationally around the UK.

PMC is a fresh engagement with a God 'who is active and present and working for good in the world'. This includes ancient spiritual practices, bringing a new attentiveness to God in scripture, as well as practical exercises and engagement with communities.

Partnership for Missional Church fosters the awareness of God's activity (Mark 16.7). In the Oxford Diocese we began our PMC journey in Berkshire in 2015 and 20 churches are now in their third year.

Year One is about 'listening' and we are just beginning this process. We are asking 24 people of all different ages, some of whom are very committed to church, some who come regularly but not in leadership positions and others who are fringe members. Each person will be asked 8 set questions and the answers are fed back anonymously to the diocese who will then read them with a view to seeing what God is doing and maybe a question or two to think about. There will be other events where we can all be involved.
