Notice is hereby given that under the Church Representation Rules a new Church Electoral Roll is being prepared. All persons who wish to have their names entered on the new Roll, whether their names are entered on the present Roll or not, are requested to apply for enrolment not later than **7 April 2019**

The Church Electoral Roll is your parish's record of those qualified to attend the Annual Parochial Church Meeting on Sunday, 28 April 2019 and to vote in elections to the parochial church council ('PCC') and the deanery synod.

Please fill in a blue Electoral Roll Form and return to Alison before Sunday, 7 April 2019 when the electoral roll will be closed until after the APCM.
