

When worship restarts – The plan for St Lawrence's, Hungerford

1 There will be a staggered start and not everything will restart at once.

On Sunday 6 September the 6.30pm will restart.

Hopefully the 4.00pm will restart in September.

2 You will not be able to sit where you usually sit. The right hand side aisle is closed because every pew which is open has to be cleaned every time the church is open.

3 There is a one way system

The main aisle flows from the back to the front and the side aisles flow from the front to the back. Hopefully this will enable social distancing.

4 Communion will be in one kind (bread) only and it will be served cathedral style. I will stand in the middle at the front. Please come to the front down main aisle, hold out your hands as far as you can and I will give you the bread. Please return to your seat down one of the side aisles so that there is a one way system.

5 The 10.00am service will be recorded.

So the preacher and leader, the readers and intercessor will all appear on the internet BUT the congregation will not appear on the internet even when you come to communion! The service will not go out live but it will be uploaded to YouTube and Facebook at 12.00.

6 Boris has asked us to record the name and phone number of people who attend for his track and trace. So you will be asked for your name a phone number as you arrive.

7 It is now the law that facemasks are worn for worship.
